A) IRONBRIDGE GORGE

Coalbrookdale and Ironbridge Community Centre is at the junction of Wellington Road and Darby Road, near to the Museum of Iron <http://www.ironbridge.org.uk/our_attractions/coalbrookdale_museum_of_iron/> and across the road from the "Coalbrookdale Watercourses", a self guided 20 minute circular walk.

C) PARKING

Parking at the community centre (signed "Coalbrookdale Watercourses P", off Darby Road) is limited; spaces will be reserved for our speakers. If the car park is full when you arrive you may be able to park on Darby Road/Coach Road (continue down Darby Road past the community centre and turn left under the railway viaduct) or on Woodside or School Road (both on the other side of Wellington Road). Pay and display parking is also available at the Museum of Iron (£1.50 for the day) – continue down Darby Road past the community centre and turn left under the railway viaduct then left again under the a railway arch, signed "Museum of Iron".

D) SEATING

The chairs in this hall are of good standard so it is unlikely that you will need to bring an extra cushion with you.

E) POSTERS

There will be a few posters and demonstrations on a variety of ONS and Industrial topics.
